

7 DAYS BEAUTY OF NEPAL



DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR – KATHMANDU (Dinner)
Upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, our local representative will meet and greet you at the airport then transfer to hotel check-in, at leisure.

DAY 02 KATHMANDU – POKHARA (approx. 6 hours drive) (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)
Today we will drive to Pokhara, the second largest and the most beautiful city in Nepal. Pokhara is famous for its breathtaking views of Mt. Fistail and Annapurna mountain ranges and beautiful lakes. Check in to hotel upon arrival. Free time for you to explore the lake side area.

DAY 03 POKHARA (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)
Wake up early morning for a 30 minutes drive to Sagarangkot located at a height of 1600m. Sarangkot is renowned for its beautiful sunrise view and the panoramic mountain views. Drive back to hotel for breakfast. Later a half-day sightseeing tour of Pokhara is in store for you. visiting World Peace Stupa, Davis Fall, the old town of Pokhara & Tibetan Refugee camp. Take an hour boating in Lake Fewa to enjoy the lake view and the mountains. After the sightseeing, you can walk around the lake side area which is filled with shops, cafes & restaurants.

DAY 04 POKHARA – KATHMANDU (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)
After breakfast, we will drive to Kathmandu enjoying the natural views along the way. Upon arrival, check in to hotel and free in the evening.

DAY 05 KATHMANDU - NAGARKOT (approx. 1.5 hours drive) (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)
After breakfast, visit the 2000 years old Swoyambhunath Stupa, (UNESCO World Heritage Site) also known as "Monkey temple" The temple charms with its great dazzling Stupa, while at the same time, offering a view of Kathmandu city. The two-thousand year-old Stupa is the most profound expression of Buddhist symbolism in Nepal. There's evidence to believe the hill was used for animist rites even before Buddhism arrived in the valley two thousand years ago. Then visit Kirtipur. Kirtipur is located 5 km from the center of Kathmandu. In Nepali dialect, Kirtipur means "a glorious town". Looking down from its natural order it has been the scene of many historic battles and many important moments in Nepal's history. History says that the ancient city Kirtipur was founded by Shiva Deva between 1099 AD. Kirtipur town is a harmonica convergence of Buddhist and Hindus. After lunch, proceed to Nagarkot located at a height of 2300 m above the sea level. From this lovely scenic spot you can catch the excellent view of the Himalayan range at sunset even Mt. Everest on a clear day.

DAY 06 NAGARKOT – KATHMANDU (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)
Wake up at dawn to catch the sunrise and enjoy the beautiful view of Himalayas from your hotel. After breakfast, a little free time allows you to enjoy the beautiful sights of the village of Nagarkot before driving back to Kathmandu. Visit Durbar square, (UNESCO World Heritage Site) which is one of the major attractions in Kathmandu Valley. The word Durbar Square translated in English as Palace Complex. The Durbar Square, with its old temples and palaces, epitomizes the religious and cultural life of the people. Interesting things to see here are Kumari (The Living Goddess) Ghar (House). At the West end of the square, is a beautiful house full of woodcarving of different God and Goddesses. This Palace is three storied and in this palace, lives the very famous living Goddess Kumari. Both Hindus and Buddhists equally venerate her. For Hindus she is the reincarnation of Hindu Goddess Kali. She is equally worshiped by Buddhists because she is chosen from Buddhist family. This shows the harmony between Buddhist and Hindus in Nepal. Later drive to Thamel which is the most tourist area of Kathmandu. Thamel has been the center of tourist industry in Nepal for over more than 4 decades. You can walk the various lanes in Thamel and do some shopping or just sit in some cafes. In the evening, attend a farewell dinner with cultural show.

DAY 07 KATHMANDU – KUALA LUMPUR (Breakfast)
Transfer to Tribhuvan International Airport.
