

# 8 DAYS WONDERFUL NEPAL



**DAY 01 Kuala Lumpur – Kathmandu (Dinner)**

Upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, our local representative will meet and greet you at the airport then proceed for sightseeing tour to Pashupatinath Temple (UNESCO World Heritage Site). Pashupatinath is one of the holiest pilgrimage destinations for all the Hindus of the world. The temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva, one of the trinity and the guardian (patron) deity of Nepal. This is one of the oldest temples, situated on the banks of the Holy Bagmati River. Lastly we will visit the Great Stupa of Boudhanath (UNESCO World Heritage Site), a vast dome-shaped monument representing the Mind of the Buddha. It is the primary pilgrimage destination for Tantric Buddhists of the Himalayas and a major draw for Tibetan Buddhists from all over the planet. After dinner, check-in to hotel.

**DAY 02 Kathmandu – Chitwan (approx. 5 hours drive) (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)**

After having breakfast, we set off to Chitwan. Chitwan offers one of the best wildlife experiences in Asia. In the evening, watch the amazing cultural show known as Tharu stick dance.

**DAY 03 Chitwan National Park (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)**

The Royal Chitwan National Park, formally was a hunting reserve for the royal families, boats of one of the richest areas in wildlife and tall grassland habitat. At dawn, stroll through the jungle, then canoe on the rapids and see the crocodiles on the riverbanks and the various species of birds. Your adventures trip is continue with elephant rides. These well-trained elephants will take you into the deeper parts of the jungle where grazing one-horned rhinos and summer deer abound. Water rafting is an optional.

**DAY 04 Chitwan – Lumbini (approx. 3.5 hours drive) (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)**

After breakfast, proceed to Bhairawa ~ Lumbini, the birthplace of Lord Buddha. On arrival, check-in to the hotel. After lunch, visit to the birthplace of Lord Buddha. The main feature built by the Indian emperor Ashoka in 249 BC.

**DAY 05 Lumbini – Pokhara (approx. 7 hours drive) (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)**

Today we will drive to Pokhara, the second largest and the most beautiful city in Nepal. Pokhara is famous for its breathtaking views of Mt. Fistail and Annapurna mountain ranges and beautiful lakes. Check in to hotel upon arrival. Free time for you to explore the lake side area.

**DAY 06 Pokhara (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)**

Wake up early morning for a 30 minutes drive to Sarangkot where located at a height of 1600m. Sarangkot is renowned for its beautiful sunrise view and the panoramic mountain views. Drive back to hotel for breakfast. Later a half-day sightseeing tour of Pokhara is in store for you. visiting World Peace Stupa, Davis Fall, the old town of Pokhara & Tibetan Refugee camp. Take an hour leisure boating on the scenic Phewa Lake and enjoy the lake view and the beautiful mountains. After the sightseeing, you can walk around the lake side area which is filled with shops, cafes & restaurants.

**DAY 07 Pokhara – Kathmandu (approx. 6 hours drive) (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)**

Drive back to Kathmandu. After the hotel check-in, you will have free time to explore this fascinating city or shopping. In the evening, attend a farewell dinner with cultural show.

**DAY 08 Kathmandu – Kuala Lumpur (Breakfast)**

Transfer to Tribhuvan International Airport.
